

SEQUENCE OF OPERATION FOR INTERIOR INTERNALLY ILLUMINATED SIGNAGE

1. LOCAL USER CONTROL:
 - a. NO LOCAL CONTROL STATIONS
 - b. PROVIDE PROGRAMMING ABILITY TO ON/OFF CONTROL GROUPS OF SIMILAR SIGN TYPES
2. NETWORK/MASTER OVERRIDE USER CONTROL:
 - a. VISIONTOUCH5 SOFTWARE
3. DIMMING:
 - a. YES, FOR EACH DIMMABLE SIGN TYPE AND LOCATION TO BE SEPARATED FOR INDIVIDUAL DIMMING CONTROL.
 - b. PROVIDE PROGRAMMING ABILITY TO DIM GROUPS OF SIMILAR SIGN TYPES
4. TIME CLOCK / OCCUPANCY CONTROL
 - a. DAYTIME / EVENING:
 - 1) SCHEDULED ON/OFF BY TIME CLOCK.
 - b. SPACE IS INTENDED FOR 24/7 OPERATION. VERIFY HOURS OF OPERATION WITH PORT PRIOR TO PROGRAMMING
5. DAYLIGHT HARVESTING:
 - a. N/A
6. INITIAL LIGHT LEVEL SETTING (FC OR %)
 - a. LEVELS TO BE SET DURING COMMISSIONING.

KEY NOTE(S):

1. EXISTING CIRCUIT NOT KNOWN. CONTRACTOR TO FIELD VERIFY, AND RECORD ON AS BUILTS FOR RECORD DRAWINGS.
2. BRANCH SIZE UPSIZED TO ACCOUNT FOR VOLTAGE DROP.
3. REUSE EXISTING SIGNAGE CIRCUIT AND RE-CONNECT TO NEW SIGNAGE.
4. EXTEND EXISTING SIGNAGE CIRCUIT TO NEW SIGNAGE. MAINTAIN EXISTING CONDUCTOR SIZE.
5. CONNECT SIGNAGE PROVIDED REMOTE DRIVER ENCLOSURE WITH MANUALLY SET DIMMER.
